

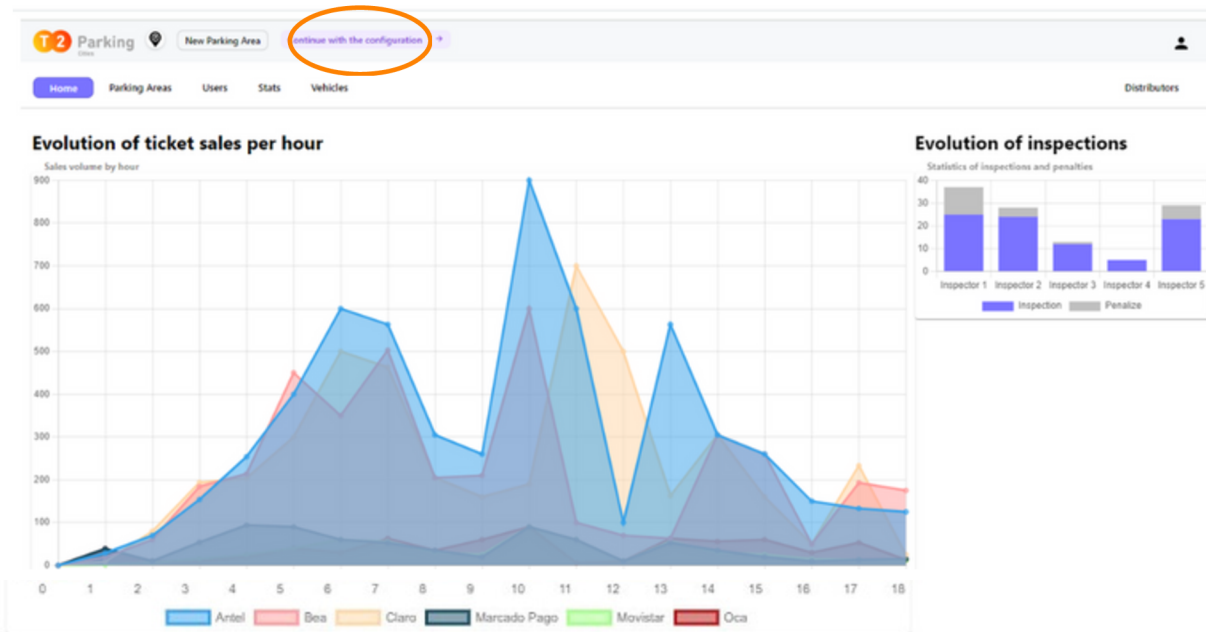
Go to the T2Parking Cities portal. Fill in the fields with your credentials and press "Continue".




Once the data is entered, press "Save".


