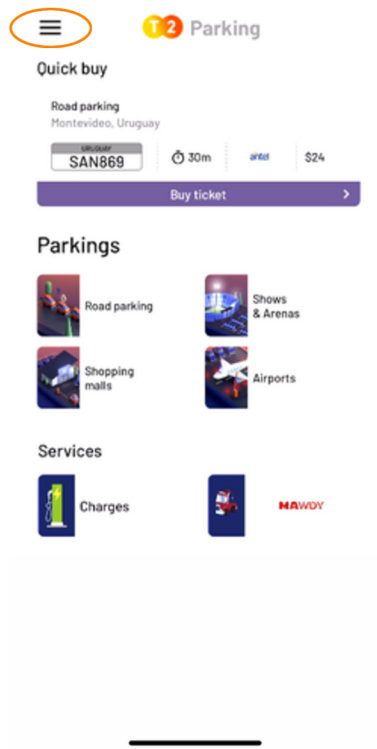


# T2Parking - Vehicle Management

## Step-by-step tutorial guide for registering, editing, and deleting vehicles.

In this tutorial, we will explain step by step how to view, add, edit, or delete vehicles in the T2Parking application.

**1** When you open the T2Parking application on your mobile, you will see the following screen. To access the vehicles section, press the burger menu at the top left.



Registering a vehicle is required by the system when entering for the first time. But registering more vehicles might be necessary or convenient at some point.

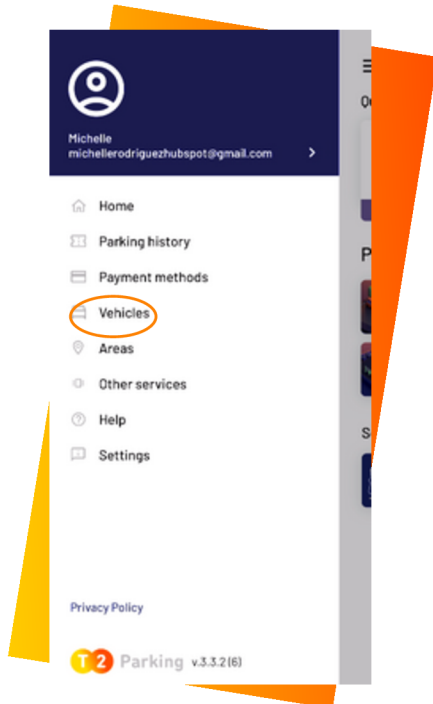
Here we will show you how to manage it in the application.

By registering your vehicles, you have quick access to parking, as in some parking lots the system recognizes the license plate, and in others, the occupation legitimacy of that place is validated.

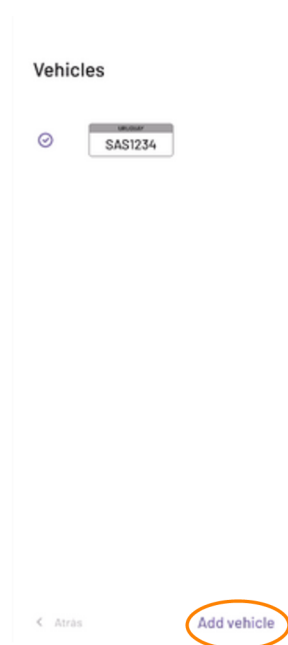
In other words, it simplifies the parking process. Additionally, the ability to add, edit, or delete vehicles gives you control over your profile.

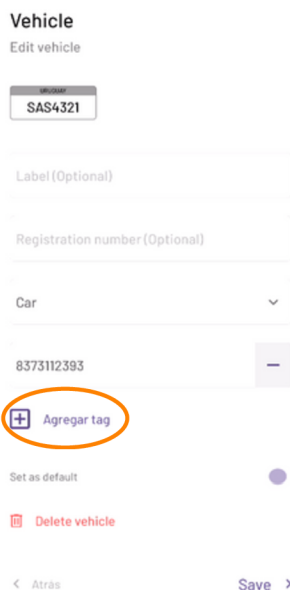
2 Select "Vehicles".



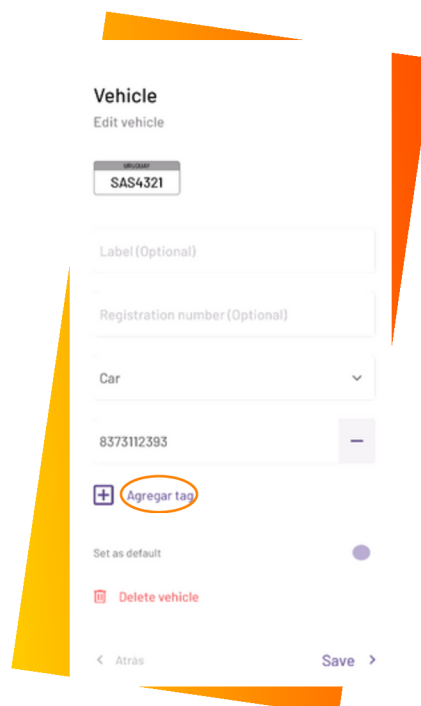
3 In this section, you will find the vehicles you have registered in your application. You can add more vehicles, delete them, or edit characteristics such as tags. Select "Add vehicle".



4 Here you can add the license plate of a vehicle, the type, and set that vehicle as the default. After completing the required data and any additional information, and if you have tags, press "Add Tag".




5 A tag is an option that will facilitate access in various places. By having your tag registered in the application, readers will identify your vehicle with that tag and automatically grant you access.





6 Remember that tags are optional. You can add as many tags as you want. To delete them, use the “-” icon next to each tag. Press “Save”.





7 If you have more than one vehicle, by pressing on the little circles, you can set it as the default. Now select the one of your preference.




